PROGRAM

As part of our program we will meet with Cuban President Miguel Diaz-Canel who will personally give us an overview of the challenges that Cuba has been facing from the brutal US economic blockade and the COVID pandemic, and how the country is creatively responding.

Throughout our visit we will witness in greater depth the challenges, and the responses through its national health care system, its social system, its international medical brigades and its mass vaccination campaign using its own vaccines.

We will be taking with us much needed medicines and medical supplies. These supplies will be things Cuba could produce for itself if it wasn't for the brutal economic war of the blockade.



SOLIDARITY CARAVANS

Since 1992 IFCO/Pastors for Peace has organized 30 Friendshipment Caravans to Cuba, delivering humanitarian aid from the people of the US to the people of Cuba and taking people to the island in defiance of the blockade.

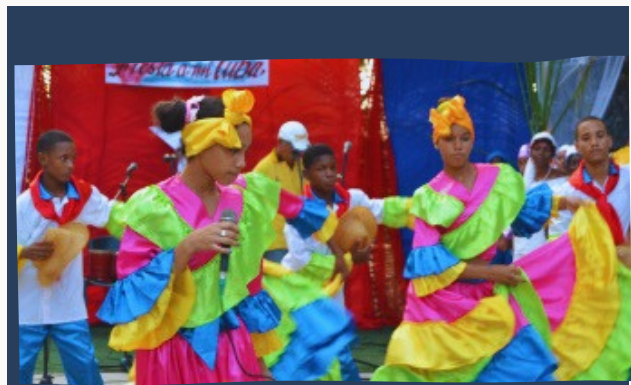
